QUALITY OF EDUCATION To be outstanding...next steps 2023-24

Objectives:

1. To raise attainment in RWM in KS2 to ensure that this is at least in line with the national average
2. Improve children's use of grammar and transcriptional skills within writing will increase the number of children working at the EXS in each year group throughout school

BEHAVIOUR AND ATTITUDES To maintain outstanding... next steps 2023-24

Objectives:

1. To increase Year 5 attendance (2022-23 – 93.8%; 2021-22 – 92.78%) to ensure that this is at least line with the school target of 96.5%.
2. Embed the updated behaviour policy so that high expectations for pupil behaviour are consistent and maintained, and positive behaviours are celebrated.

Objectives:

1. Achieve the RKA 'Red Award' (Respect, Equality and Diversity) as we celebrate difference.
2. Introduce the Whitkirk Way and educational visits/ visitors overview to enhance our curriculum offer in line with the DfE Activity Passport.
